Name: Robert "Bob" Dodge

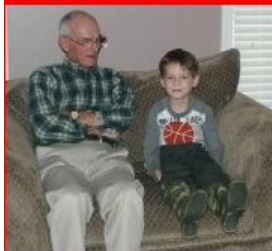
Age of First Dodgecup Appearance: 77
